
Step 1: The Crucifixion Scene


- 1. Cut out the cross and stick it on plate #1.
- 2. Cut out the words and stick around the cross or write in your own words describing the death of Jesus.
- 3. You can colour in the background if you wish.



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Step 2: The Tomb Scene

- 1. Cut out the tomb below and stick onto plate #2 or draw your own version of the tomb in the centre.
- 2. Cut out the words you want to use and stick them on the plate or write in your own words that Jesus has risen from the dead.
- Attach plate #2 on top of plate #1 by using a brad on the top of the plates. (You'll need mom or dad to help with poking the holes.)



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Step 3: The Stone


- 1. Cut out the stone on the next page.
- 2. Cut out the words and stick it onto the stone cut-out or write your own words about how the stone was rolled away.
- 3. Attach the stone cut-out on plate #2, only with the brad at the bottom. (You'll need mom or dad's help with poking the holes.)

For 3 days, Jesus' body lay in the tomb. But on the 3rd day the stone was rolled away!
